



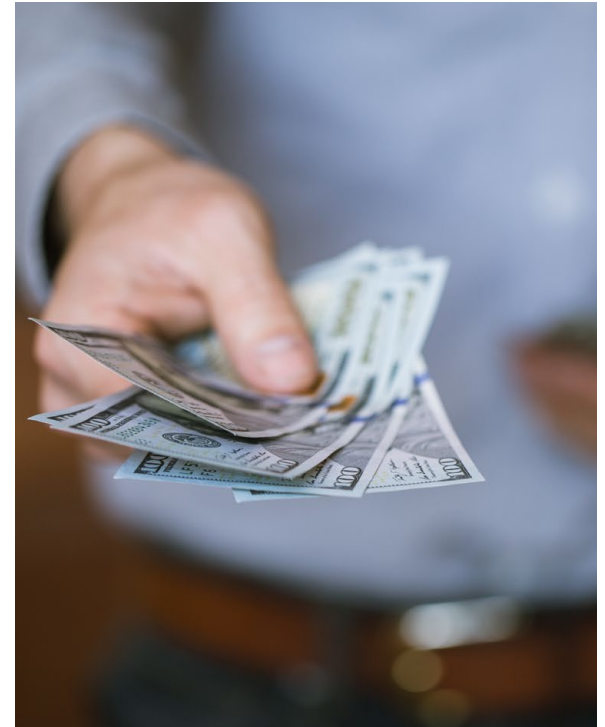
PROVIDE A CLEANair FURNACE REBATE INSTANTLY

Install more ultra-low NOx qualified units by offering an instant CLEANair Furnace Rebate at the kitchen table. This option provides a consumer with a point of sale rebate which reduces their upfront cost while accelerating your sales and reducing customer calls for misplaced documentation.

To take advantage of this opportunity, itemize your invoice to show that the customer instantly received the full value of the CLEANair Furnace Rebate at time of sale. Then, complete the online application and submit the dually signed customer release form and the customer signed invoice showing full job details. Upon application approval, you will receive the full amount of the rebate from the CLEANair Furnace Rebate Program. Please allow 4-6 weeks from the approval of your application to receive the rebate payment.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE

- 1 Contractor negotiates payment with their customer for a CLEANair qualifying furnace project, deducting the CLEANair Furnace Rebate amount from the customer's total payment.
- 2 After project completion, the Contractor completes the rebate application and uploads the supporting documentation including a dually signed customer release form, to the CLEANair Furnace Rebate Program.
Note: The customer release form must contain an original customer AND contractor signature. Digital signatures will not be allowed.
- 3 Upon verification and approval of the rebate application, the CLEANair Furnace rebate check is made out and mailed directly to the Contractor.

ONLINE PROCESS

- 1 Go online to www.cleanairfurnacerebate.com
- 2 Fill out the application fields including customer information and installation address
- 3 Select the furnace brand and model number from the drop downs
- 4 Upload the customer signed invoice showing:
 - a. Purchase Date
 - b. Installation Date
 - c. Furnace Manufacturer, Full Model #, Full Serial #
 - d. Total cost of installation
 - e. The full rebate amount deducted from the total invoice price clearly labeled as CLEANair Furnace Rebate
- 5 Upload the signed Customer Release Form

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- In order to receive payment directly, the rebate application documentation must be accompanied by a signed Contractor Direct Rebate Option Customer Release Form acknowledging customer authorization to release their rebate payment to the Contractor.
- By providing an application with an accompanying invoice for payment, the Contractor is certifying that charges and other work described in the application is an accurate and a correct record of services performed for reimbursement by the CLEANair Furnace Rebate Program.
- All rebated furnaces are subject to an on-site inspection at the discretion of SCAQMD.
- Contractor agrees to act and represent its business as an independent contractor and at no time will Contractor or any of the Contractor's employees represent its business as an employee, agent, partner or representative of SCAQMD or the CLEANair Furnace Rebate Program. Contractor has no right or power to bind SCAQMD or act on its behalf when dealing with customers or third parties.
- Contractor understands that SCAQMD is not endorsing a Contractor's business, or warranting or endorsing any equipment that may be sold by the Contractor. Under no circumstances shall SCAQMD be liable to the Contractor for any direct or indirect losses, costs or damages arising from or related to any equipment or installation under the program.
- Contractor's participation in the Contractor Direct Rebate Option and provision of the rebate is voluntary and at the sole discretion and risk of the Contractor. The provision of work or services to the customer does not guarantee payment of a rebate to the contractor by SCAQMD or the CLEANair Furnace Rebate Program.
- Funding is limited and submitting a rebate application does not guarantee you will receive a rebate. Rebates will be issued on a first-come, first-served basis until funding is depleted. Applicants with SCAQMD qualified ultra-low NOx furnaces installed during the rebate period are eligible until rebate funds are exhausted or SCAQMD issues a public notice closing the rebate offer period.
- Rebate amounts are subject to change.
- All applications are required to be accurate in all manners related to the furnace details, quantity, location, and installation status. Failure of any application to meet these standards will trigger an investigation of the issues. If it is found that the Contractor was negligent in meeting the requirements or terms and conditions of the program, the Contractor will be required to refund the rebate amount, including all associated processing costs.
- Items must be installed and in working order prior to submission of the rebate paperwork.
